## News

Across the whole beat area during the month of January, the following number of crimes were reported.

Vehicle Crime: 11. Three of these involved HGV's parked at LFE Services.

Burglary: 3 incidents reported.

Criminal Damage: 5. Two of these involved HGV's parked at LFE Services.

Anti-Social Behaviour: 1 incident reported.

### Theft from Vans.

**Don't assume your vehicle has locked properly using a key fob lock. Criminals can use devices which block the signal. Always check your doors are locked before leaving your vehicle unattended, if you have a keyless van invest in a signal blocker.**

**If you are staying in a hotel, where possible remove your tools from your van and keep them in your room overnight.**

**Don't leave tools in vehicles unattended or overnight. Place a sign in the window stating they have been removed.**

### Leicestershire Police Moving Back To Basics

In 2022, Leicestershire Police has been analysing how they can put the right resources in the right place at the right time to prevent and detect burglary.

Operation Fortune, running in the Hinckley and Blaby area since September, has seen increased proactive police patrols, leading to 32 arrests and 19 properties searched for stolen material. Stolen property has been recovered including vehicles, drugs and cash. Burglary has reduced in the area by 40%.

**CRIME UPDATES - #YouSaidWeDid** -Please find below updates from your local beat team in relation to the priorities you have raised via Neighbourhood Link:

### **You Said – Anti-Social Behaviour**

**We Did** – We have seen a return of knock door run incidents in Leicester Forest East, groups of young people have been spoken to whilst the beat team have been patrolling the area. If you are experiencing issues similar please report them to us via 101 or our website.

### **You Said – Residential Burglary**

**We Did** – In the last week a suspect has been arrested for a number of burglaries including ones that happened on the beat. This arrest is in result to our CID department putting in some great work. Although someone has been arrested the hard work continues.

### **You Said – Vehicle Crime**

**We Did** – We are aware of people going around and trying car doors across the area and we are patrolling across the beat to deter and hopefully capture those responsible. Don't make it easy for them leaving vehicles insecure or valuables/cash/cards in your car we are seeing an increase in cards being used if found in cars due to the increased spending limit of contactless transactions. Don't get caught out.

### **You Said – Road Safety**

**We Did** – The beat team have spent time around the schools as we are still receiving a few complaints in relation to poor parking.

### **#InYourCommunity - Beat Surgeries –**

New beat surgeries will be created by new members of the beat team.
