- New welcome to Leicester Forest East signs have been put up;
- Unqualified external audit report (required to maintain General Power of Competence) and minimal/minor 'findings'/advisory points on internal audit report;
- Began to populate the 3-year plan with figures;
- Went through the election process;
- Continued general power of competence achieved;
- Gavel and plinth and chains of office updated with all previous chairmen; and
- LiFE Magazine Published LiFE x 2 editions
