Share the Road Campaign

Share The Road is a road safety campaign led by Leicestershire Police.

The Share the Road campaign focuses on anyone that uses the roads and encourages everyone to treat each other respectfully.

The aim is to ensure that anyone in Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland that uses the road, for any purpose is kept safe.

We have consulted professionals from a number of partners who are supporting our campaign to make the roads a safer place, including: The British Horse Society, British Triathlon and Cycling UK.

Advice - Cyclists

Make sure your **intention is clear** and signal to other road users when you intend to turn, giving plenty of notice before manoeuvring.

Light up! Legally you are required to have working lights on the front and rear of your cycle, switched on between sunset and sunrise; white at the front, red at the rear.

Advice - Car Drivers

Pass cyclists, horse riders and runners wide and slow. The recommended distance is 1.5 metres.

When passing a horse and rider, slow down to a maximum of 15mph and be patient if looking to go around them.

Note the new rural areas where the speed limits have dropped to 50mph

Please find below updates from your local beat team in relation to the priorities you have raised via Neighbourhood Link:

You Said – Anti-Social Behaviour

We Did – Over the last couple of months the beat team have been dealing with anti-social behaviour at Morrison's and surrounding area of Glenfield. The young people committing this anti-social behaviour have been spoken to and we are in the process of visiting address of those involved.

You Said – Vehicle Crime

We Did – As the hot weather is with us we are seeing a rise in cars being left insecure whether that is by leaving the car unlocked or the windows/sunroof bring open. Don't let opportunists take advantage of this ensure your vehicle is secure even is leaving it for a few minutes.

You Said – Road Safety

We Did – Our volunteers have again been out this month at a number of locations conducting speed checks all of those who were caught speeding have been dealt with appropriately. PCSO Calum has recovered several vehicles over the last month for no tax with one having ran out in early 2020! If you do buy a car you must tax it straight away the law changed quite a while ago in relation to this.
