## Keyless car thefts -

There has been an increase in keyless car thefts of late. Specifically **Range Rovers** and **Land Rovers**.

What can you do?

- Keep your keys away from Doors and windows overnight.
- Keep them in something that blocks the signal. A metal container or a RFID blocking pouch.
- Double check your car is locked.
- Consider fitting a vehicle tracker.
- Store your car in a locked garage or in a well-lit area and places covered by CCTV.
- Be vigilant, report any suspicious activity to the Police. Report by calling 101 or via our website www.leics.police.uk

Please find below updates from your local beat team in relation to the priorities you have raised via Neighbourhood Link:

#### You Said - Anti-Social Behaviour

**We Did** –We had very few ASB reports over Halloween which is very positive. We proactively conducted patrols and will also conduct patrols for Bonfire night as well.

A school talk was conducted by PCSO Calum at The Hall School. He talked about Bonfire night, Halloween and ASB.

#### You Said - Vehicle Crime

**We Did** – Patrols are continuing to help prevent vehicle crime. Two people were arrested at the LFE services for stealing from cars. The investigation is ongoing. We are actively giving crime prevention advice to the owners of high-risk vehicles, please see the news section in the newsletter for more information.

#### You Said – Road Safety

**We Did** – There is a Road safety talk planned for the whole school at the Hall School in Glenfield on the 24<sup>th</sup> November.

Patrols are ongoing regarding the road closure in Kirby Muxloe. There have been a few reports regarding people ignoring the road closure and driving on the pavement round the cones to get by.

#### You Said - Residential Burglary

**We Did** – Two suspects were arrested for a burglary in LFE. The investigation is ongoing. We continue to patrol in key area as a deterrent.
