Keeping you safe this festive season

Have fun and enjoy yourselves this Christmas – but please ensure you celebrate safely and look out for your family and friends.

That's the message from Leicestershire Police this year as the festive season fast approaches and as officers and staff plan for the month ahead to ensure we are here to help keep you safe.

Officers will continue to be out in communities across Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland throughout the month carrying out proactive patrols and working to keep residents safe. Extra patrols and shifts are also planned for key dates across Christmas and New Year which are usually some of the busiest nights of the year for the force.

Our licensing teams across force have also been working with pubs, bars and clubs and licensing teams within local authorities. This work includes continuing to ensure premises are aware of signs to look out for in relation to potential spiking incidents and that any incident is immediately reported to the police.

Chief Inspector Manjit Atwal said: "We have been planning for several months in force to ensure we have resources in place and are fully prepared for the upcoming busy festive season. Our officers will be out and about on proactive high-visibility patrols both at day and night to help you, to keep you safe and to respond quickly and effectively to any reports and incidents when we are required.

"Please continue to work with us during this time too. Please ensure you plan ahead when having a night out and that you look out for yourselves and your friends. If you feel unsafe on a night out or start to feel unwell, make sure you tell someone such as a member of bar staff. Report any suspicious behaviour or incidents to the police.

#YouSaidWeDid -Please find below updates from your local beat team in relation to the priorities you have raised via Neighbourhood Link:

You Said - Anti-Social Behaviour

We Did –Over the last month we have seen vehicle related anti-social behaviour reports in both Kirby Muxloe and Glenfield. Officers have spoken to those involved and any further incidents that get reported will result in Section 59 Warnings being issued. You Said - Vehicle Crime

We Did – The beat team have worked with our local CID dept assisting with investigations relating to theft of motor vehicles with some vehicles being recovered. This month we have also seen number plate thefts occur across the beat you may want to consider purchasing security screws for your number plates. They come in various sizes to fit specific vehicles.

You Said - Road Safety

We Did – At the start of November we received numerous complaints regarding parking outside DPD in Glenfield. The beat team spoke with management and also recovered a small number of cars causing an obstruction. Since then the beat team have monitored this area with no further incidents reported.

You Said - Residential Burglary

We Did – Some further good news this month a suspect that was arrested in relation to a burglary at the start of November in Leicester Forest East has been charged and awaits their day in court. Just a reminder from last month we are encouraging keyless car drivers to purchase signal block pouches to store your keys.
