(b) Christmas Lights 2022-2024, plus Christmas tree outside St. Andrew's Church

In relation to the Christmas tree at St. Andrew's Church:

- The Church would like to know who would be responsible for maintaining any tree planted there, i.e. the Church or the Parish Council?
- The Church have confirmed there is no cost for the faculty (the permission from the diocese to plant a Christmas tree in the Church grounds).
- The Church would be happy with a small permanent tree with a bigger cut tree for a few
 years until the permanent tree grows to a suitable size.
- BDC have confirmed no planning permission would be needed to plant a tree at the Church grounds.

The Committee made the decision that it would be happy for St. Andrew's Church to maintain the planted Christmas tree.

Clerk to:

- Inform St. Andrew's Church that the Committee would be happy for the Church to maintain the planted Christmas tree.
- Obtain quotes for a root ball Christmas tree to be planted in St. Andrew's Church grounds.
- (c) To discuss £25,000 funding each County Councillor is receiving for Highways Improvements No further update.
- (d) To consider where to use an anti-dog fouling stencil around the parish

District Councillor Coar has now provided the Clerk with several locations where dog mess is an issue around the parish. Also, the Clerk explained that she had emailed BDC several times to obtain the antidog fouling stencils but had not yet received a response.

Clerk to:

- Ask if BDC have a Dog Warden. If so, can they come and do spot checks on Forest East Park?
- Chase up the anti-dog fouling stencils kit from BDC again.
- Ask the volunteer litter-picker to spray the anti-dog fouling stencils at Carnation Close, teal Close, Woodpecker Close, Lark Close, Swallow Close, Kings Drive, the walkway between Somerfield Way and Juniper Close and the Somerfield Way car park.
