Leicestershire Police graded as Outstanding in tackling serious and organised crime according to a report by HMICFRS.

An official report published today has graded Leicestershire Police as outstanding at tackling serious and organised crime.

The report issued by His Majesty's Inspectorate of Constabulary and Fire and Rescue Services (HMICFRS) has graded the force at the highest level stating Leicestershire Police "has an integrated approach and effectively manages serious organised crime". The report recognises this approach stems from an executive level through to frontline policing.

Crime Prevention

Garden Shed Security.

With Spring just around the corner and the lighter nights approaching, thefts from gardens and garden sheds often increase. There are some simple steps homeowners can take to protect their garden equipment.

Put tools and equipment away after use.

Ensure garage doors are closed and valuables are kept out of sight.

Install a shed alarm, security lighting and good strong padlocks on gates.

CRIME UPDATES - #YouSaidWeDid

Please find the below updates from your local beat team in relation to the priorities you have raised via Neighbourhood Link:

You Said – Anti-Social Behaviour

We have had a number of reports about groups of people in the evenings around Morrisons in Glenfield being abusive to customers and staff.

We Did – We have been speaking with staff at the location and have identified regular times and days when this behaviour occurs. In response, the beat team are conducting regular patrols of the area during these times in an effort to engage with, and deal with poor behaviour where necessary, the groups. If you are experiencing any issues please report them to us via 101 or our website.

You Said – Residential Burglary

There were 10 residential burglaries across Leicester Forest East, Kirby Muxloe and Glenfield during February. Three occurred in Glenfield and seven in LFE.

We Did – Since October as a Neighbourhood Policing Area, Hinckley and Blaby Police have had an operation running including LFE, Kirby Muxloe and Glenfield targeting residential burglaries. This has been highly successful. There has been:

- 49 arrests with 7 of those being remanded and 24 bailed or released pending further enquiries being carried out
- 23 stop searches have been conducted in areas where offences have been most prevalent
- 31 addresses have been searched that have been linked to burglary offences
- 15 vehicles have been searched that have been lined to burglary offence

You Said – Vehicle Crime

We Did – We are aware of people going around and trying car doors across the area and we are patrolling across the beat to deter and hopefully capture those responsible. Don't make it easy for them leaving vehicles insecure or valuables/cash/cards in your car we are seeing an increase in cards being used if found in cars due to the increased spending limit of contactless transactions. Don't get caught out.

You Said – Road Safety

We Did – The beat team have spent time around the schools as we are still receiving a few complaints in relation to poor parking.
