The most challenging of my tasks has been to set up an office both locally and at Westminster, as well as recruit staff, and respond to the hundreds of pieces of correspondence that I have received since the General Election. It is my intention to hold surgeries fortnightly (Fridays: 10am-2pm); and once these are up and running I will advertise to residents via my articles and social media platforms.

Some of my activities over the summer have included...

- Speaking on BBC Radio Leicester about the environmental concerns in LFE with Casepak and the fly swarms;
- Meeting Markfield disability campaigner, Simon Sansome, to hear what more can be done to support those with mobility challenges;
- A visit to the University of Leicester to discuss jobs, skills and training;
- A tour of Mountsorrel quarry to understand the impacts of any extension and what mitigations could be introduced should it go ahead;
- A residents meeting in Ratby to discuss concerns about the HBBC's Local Plan and implications for The Burroughs;
- Attended the opening of the Jubilee Hall extension in Anstey part funded by the UK Shared Prosperity Fund;
- An introduction to the new ME Sports Community Centre in Markfield;

On a Parliamentary level many residents have written to me about the New Government's proposals to scrap the Universal Winter Fuel Payment. I would like to assure residents that I will be fighting this cut and will be speaking on it in Parliament during the coming months.
